Waters Senior Living on 50th

Project Description:

- Four story building with approximately 60 underground parking spaces and 10 surface spaces designed to complement adjacent building on 50th
- Design to complement adjacent building across 50th Street

Project Financing:

- First mortgage of approximately \$14,750,000
- Second tax-exempt mortgage of approximately \$2,500,000 (TIF supported)
- Equity of \$3,250,000
- CPED \$975,000 (AHTF request of \$450,000)
- Twenty year pay-as-you go tax increment assistance
- No developer fee paid
- Market demand assisted living 263 units (4 times) & memory support 204 units (almost 10 times)

- Building opening spring of 2013
