
Please Always Remember to close Lock Your Doors!

WHAT YOU CAN DO:

- Call 911 on suspicious activity at the time it occurs
- Lock your doors and windows (vehicles, homes, garages)
- Record the make/model/serial number on all valuables (Very important for bikes!)
- Install a deadbolt on your garage service door and consider an audible alarm
- Properly secure your bike with a lock that is difficult to compromise, like a u-lock.
