Forced entry property crimes

November 17 At about 6:05 p.m., officers were dispatched to an alarm at a home on the 5100 block of York. The resident arrived shortly thereafter and noticed that the back door of the house appeared to have been kicked and the lock broken. The door was still closed and locked, and there was no loss.

November 17 Between 4:35 and 7:15 p.m., an unknown suspect kicked in the rear door of a home on the 5300 block of Abbott and took a silver bar and collectibles from a dresser in a bedroom.

November 18 Between 7:30 a.m. and 9:30 p.m., an unknown suspect kicked in the back door of a home on the 5600 block of Thomas in Armatage. There was no information about whether anything was stolen.

November 24 Between 8 a.m. November 24 and 10:20 a.m. November 25, an unknown suspect attempted to burglarize a home on the 5700 block of Morgan in Armatage. The suspect broke the glass on a side door and removed a window screen, but failed to gain entry.

November 25 Between November 25 and 29, an unknown suspect cut the spare tire carrier assembly of a vehicle which was parked on the street on the 6100 block of Vincent in Armatage and stole the tire and rim.

November 30 Between 5 and 8 a.m., an unknown suspect broke into a vehicle which was parked inside a garage on the 5000 block of Oliver in Lynnhurst and took a car stereo.

November 30 Between 12:30 and 9 p.m., an unknown suspect kicked in the back door of a home on the 5100 block of Upton, entered the home, and stole a laptop computer, lockbox, TV, jewelry, and cash.

December 1 Between noon December 1 and 8:30 a.m. December 2, an unknown suspect pushed and dislodged the window of a garage on the 4900 block of Zenith. No entry was made.

December 1 Between 7:30 p.m. and 7 a.m., an unknown suspect pried the protective metal plate from the front door of One Hour Martinizing, 5559 Xerxes Ave in Armatage. No entry was made.

Unsecured property

November 9 Between 6 a.m. November 9 and 10 p.m. November 10, an unknown suspect entered a garage on the 5000 block of Colfax in Lynnhurst and took unlisted items from a vehicle which was parked inside. The overhead garage door was unsecure due to a broken door opener.

November 18 Between 8:30 p.m. and 7 a.m., an unknown suspect stole tools from a truck which was parked in the rear of a home on the 4900 block of Upton. The suspect gained entry to the locked truck through a topper which was not locked.

November 29 Between 7 p.m. and 8 a.m., an unknown suspect entered an unlocked garage on the 4900 block of Dupont in Lynnhurst and stole a vehicle which was parked inside. The keys were in the vehicle.

Arrests

November 9 At about 3:25 p.m., police were dispatched to an aggressive panhandler who was harassing a 12-year-old female at the exit ramp from westbound Crosstown Highway 62 at Xerxes Ave in Armatage. The suspect was on MNDOT property within one foot of the roadway holding a sign requesting money. The officer noted that this is an ongoing problem and that the suspect had been cited for trespassing at the same location on July 9. 49-year-old Kevin Charles Smith of 5544 Newton Ave South was arrested for trespassing and booked in the jail. Smith has prior convictions in Hennepin County for trespassing (2), disorderly conduct, driving while intoxicated, theft, and 4th degree criminal sexual conduct.

November 28 At about 12:10 a.m., police found two suspects in Linden Hills Park near 43rd & York. A 17-year-old male was cited for a petty misdemeanor narcotics violation, possession of drug paraphernalia, possession of liquor by a minor, and consumption of liquor by a minor. 19-year-old Evan James Finley of 3917 York Ave South was cited for a petty misdemeanor narcotics violation, consumption of liquor by a minor, and carrying a weapon without a permit.

Other incident

November 21 At about 6:20 p.m., two suspects robbed the Super USA store at 5965 Penn Ave in Armatage at gunpoint. The suspects fled on foot. The loss was unlisted.
