7th Annual BLEND and Eco-**BLEND Awards and Ceremony**





The annual BLEND Awards for homes and businesses that blend in with their neighbors, as well as the EcoBLEND Award for the incorporation of sustainable initiatives in residential and commercial projects, will be presented from 7 to 10 p.m. Mon., Sept. 16, at the Fulton Brewery, 414 6th Ave N, Minneapolis.

The B.L.E.N.D. Award (Buildings and Landscapes Enhancing the Neighborhood through Design) encourages and rewards builders, architects, and home owners whose newly remodeled or constructed homes and businesses blend into the existing neighborhood design aesthetics. The EcoBLEND Award encourages and rewards eco-friendly design and sustainable building practices in both new and remodeled projects in Minneapolis. The award will evaluate nominees in four areas including resource efficiency, water conservation, indoor environmental quality, and energy efficiency.

Over the past seven years, the BLEND Award has grown from a neighborhood -wide into a city-wide award, has incorporated the EcoBLEND Award, and now includes corporate sponsors. The corporate sponsors have allowed the BLEND and EcoBLEND Awards to further advocate our mission and recognize selected projects. MSP FairSkies Coalition


MSP FairSkies Coalition is a group of residents working to make sure we have a say in airport issues that impact levels of airplane noise and air pollution in our neighborhoods.

MSP airport issues will impact neighborhoods: proposed RNAV flight paths which would place heavily concentrated tracks directly over neighborhoods and schools and an airport expansion to accommodate a projected 20 percent increase in air traffic.
