On Oct. 19, 20 area residents gathered to walk along Minnehaha Creek from Zenith Ave S to the Lynnhurst Community Center. They discussed the current condition of the area and any improvements they would like to see along the stretch. Ideas generated include removing the concrete spillways, preserving green space, educational signage, erosion control and alternative material pathways. Over the next few months we will be generating a formal survey for all residents to give input. Please keep your eye out for the survey in early 2014.
