

Fulton Safety Committee report – February 10, 2016

Crime reports

January 22 At about 12:05 p.m., four non-student suspects entered Southwest High School, 3414 West 47th St., without permission, located a student in an occupied classroom, entered the classroom, and physically assaulted the student, resulting in physical injury.

January 22 Between January 22 and 26, an unknown suspect forced open the front door of a home on the 5000 block of Vincent and took unlisted items.

January 24 Between 6 p.m. January 24 and 12:30 p.m. January 25, an unknown suspect entered a garage on the 4900 block of York through an unlocked service door, rummaged through vehicles which were parked inside, and took a SuperAmerica gift card.

January 24 Between 8 p.m. and 9 a.m., an unknown suspect entered a garage on the 4800 block of Upton and stole cash from a vehicle which was parked inside. There was no sign of forced entry. A resident could not remember whether the service door was locked.
