Financial Policies and Procedures

September is the deadline for FNA to submit its financial policies and procedures to the City's Neighborhood Participation Program. Ruth found and updated FNA's original document from a number of years ago. The committee recommended that the Board approve the following changes:

- Under "Processing Reimbursement Requests", add <u>The coordinator is authorized to pay recurring</u> <u>bills which are within 10% of the usual amount.</u> Currently there are three recurring bills.
- Under "Deposits", change the second bullet point to <u>Treasurer verifies and logs all checks/cash in</u> <u>deposit log.</u>
- Under "Bank Reconciliations", add text to the third bullet point: Coordinator conveys the reconciled bank statement, along with corresponding documentation, to the FNA Treasurer <u>who</u> <u>then signs the reconciliation statement.</u>

Other business

TCF Bank has announced that it will move its operation at 5018 France Ave to the former Dairy Queen property at 3709 West 50th St. The new bank will include drive-through service.
