

Fulton Safety Committee report: December 13, 2017

Crime reports

November 8 At about 11:20 a.m., a person was waiting at a Metro Transit bus stop at 47th & Xerxes. Suspects approached the person and asked for his wallet. The suspects then forcefully took the person's wallet from his back pants pocket. The person's credit card was subsequently used fraudulently at Target. The incident was reported to police on November 13.

November 10 At about 6:10 p.m., a 15-year-old male was booked in the Juvenile Detention Center after being arrested by Edina Police at 50th & France for aggravated robbery of person.

November 12 At about 9:20 p.m., police responded to an incident of arson at Pershing Park, 3523 West 48th St. Firefighters were at the scene and extinguished the fire. The arson investigator was notified. There is limited information about the suspect.

November 13 At about 11 a.m., police responded to an incident of arson in the parking garage of Pinehurst Properties, 4999 France Ave.

November 13 Between 8:30 p.m. and 6:40 a.m., an unknown suspect entered a vehicle which was parked in the driveway of a home on the 4800 block of York, rummaged through it, and took unlisted items.

November 15 The manager of Anthropologie, 4999 France Ave., reported that a theft occurred at the store between 6:30 and 8:30 p.m.

November 17 At about 3:10 p.m., a suspect entered General Sports, 5025 France Ave., with a group of teenagers. The suspect was seen on surveillance video stealing a soccer jersey and a hockey jersey.

November 20 Between midnight and 6 a.m., an unknown suspect entered an unlocked vehicle which was parked on the street on the 4700 block of Washburn, rummaged through it, and took \$45 cash.

November 23 Between 11 a.m. and 7:40 p.m., an unknown suspect kicked in the back door of a home on the 5100 block of Upton and took unlisted item(s). Officers checked the home. No suspects were located.

November 27 At about 1:40 a.m., a surveillance camera at an address on the 5000 block of Abbott recorded video of a vehicle which drove through the alley behind the home and a person who then took unlisted item(s) from the driveway.

November 27 Between 3:30 and 4:00 p.m., an unknown suspect pried open the rear passenger side window of a vehicle which was parked in the lot of the commercial building at 5011 Ewing Ave and took leather bags and a laptop computer valued at \$4,800. Some of the items were recovered in a nearby parking ramp. A business in the area may have surveillance video of the incident.

December 5 Between 5 p.m. December 5 and 10:30 a.m. December 6, an unknown suspect took unlisted items from a house on Forest Dale Road which is under construction.

December 8 Between 3:00 and 6:30 p.m., an unknown suspect broke the rear driver's side window of a vehicle which was parked in the lot at Coalition Restaurant, 3808 West 50th St., and took a bag containing business documents.

December 8 Between 5:00 and 7:05 p.m., an unknown suspect broke the side windows of three vehicles which were parked in the City of Minneapolis parking lot at 5044 Ewing Ave and took unlisted items. A business on France Ave may have surveillance video of the incidents.

December 8 Between 4:30 and 7:15 p.m., an unknown suspect damaged a vehicle which was parked at Terzo, 2221 West 50th St., and took unlisted item(s).

December 9 Between 1:30 and 7:30 p.m., an unknown suspect broke a window of a vehicle which was parked in a restaurant lot near 50th & France and took a backpack containing a laptop computer.
