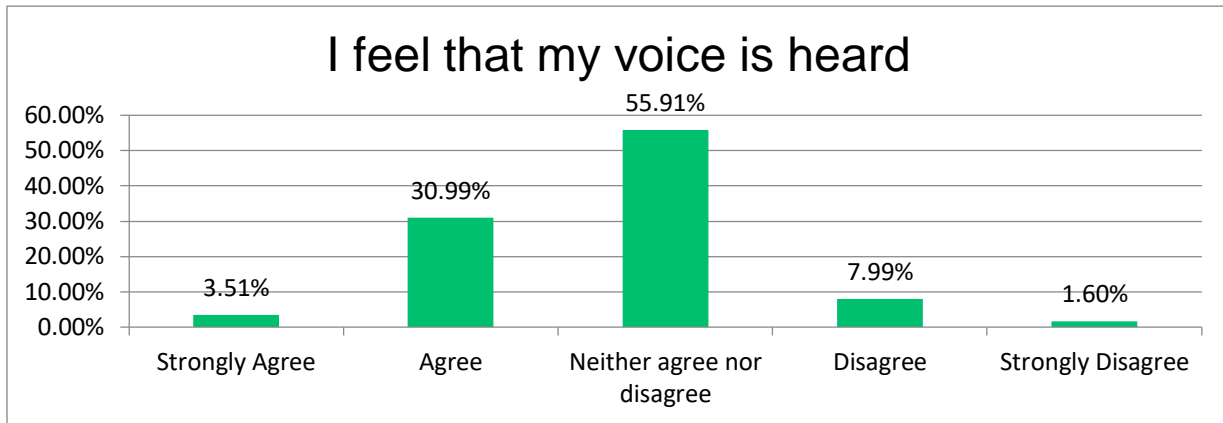
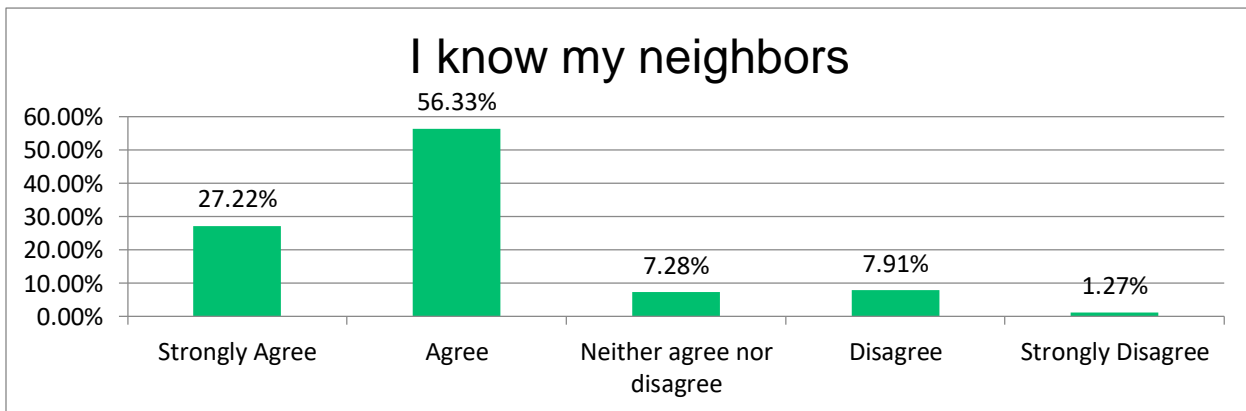


This survey was sent out to all houses in Fulton this spring. All household members were invited to participate by filling out a paper copy of the survey and by responding online.

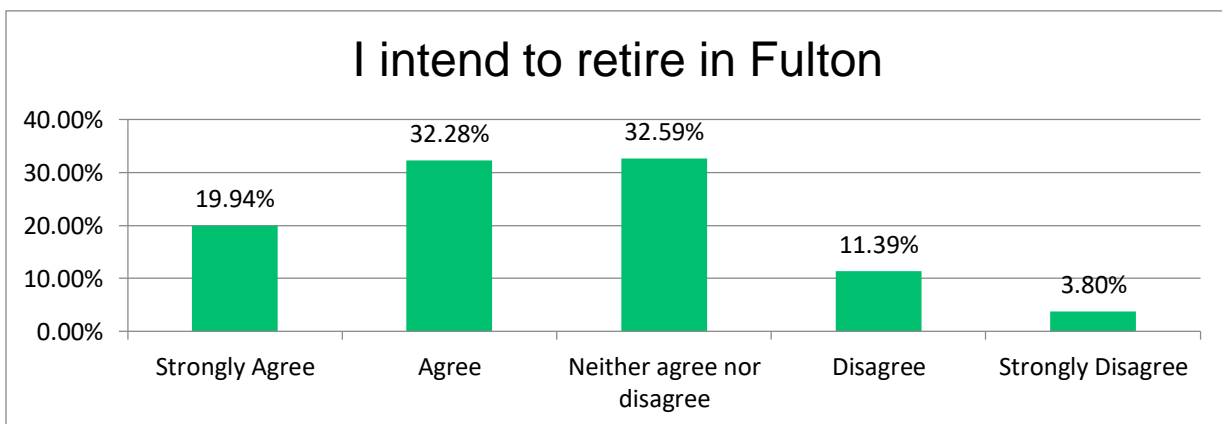
329 people responded to our survey. These responses will be used to inform the work of the Fulton Neighborhood Association.



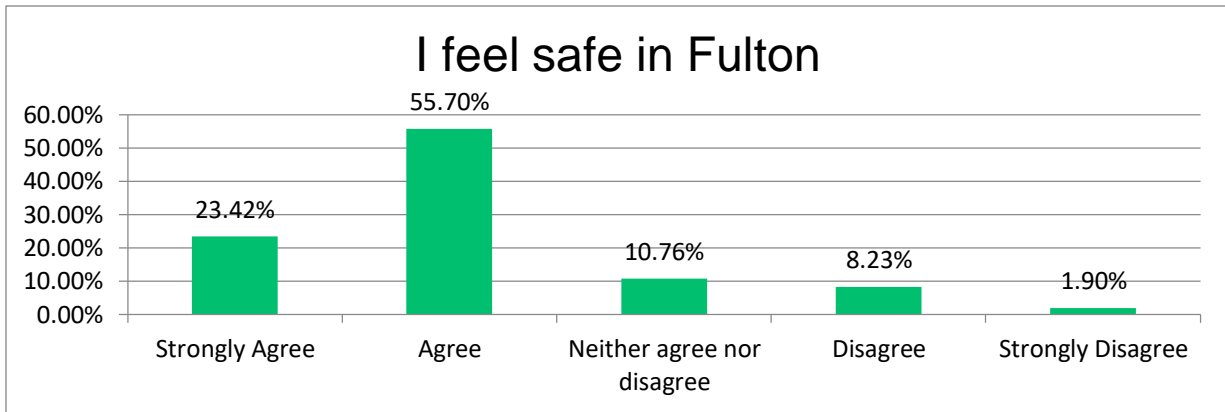
34% of Respondents feel that their voices are heard

A majority of respondents (52%) intend to retire in Fulton

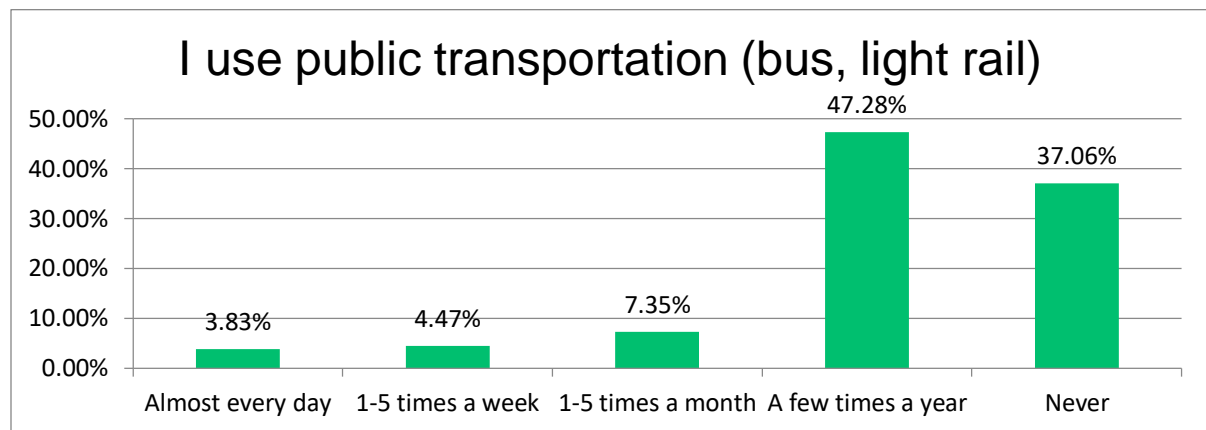


A majority of respondents (79%) feel safe in Fulton

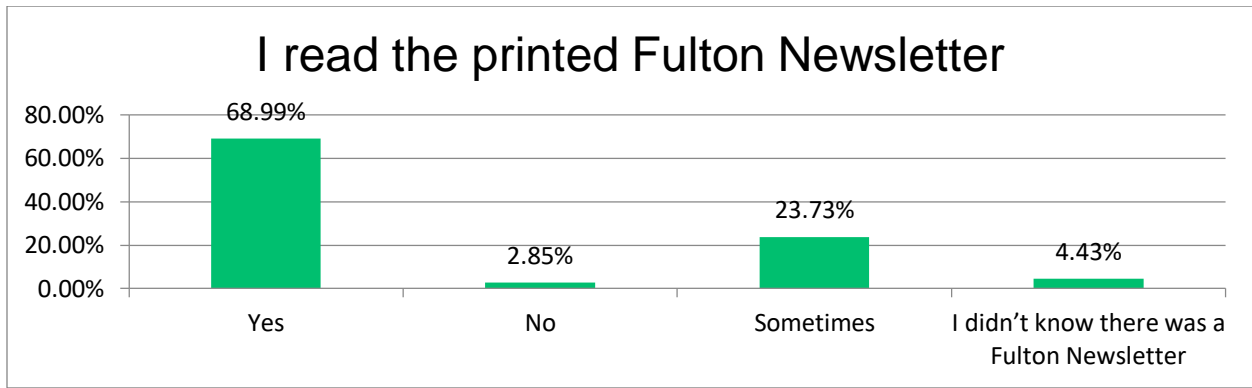

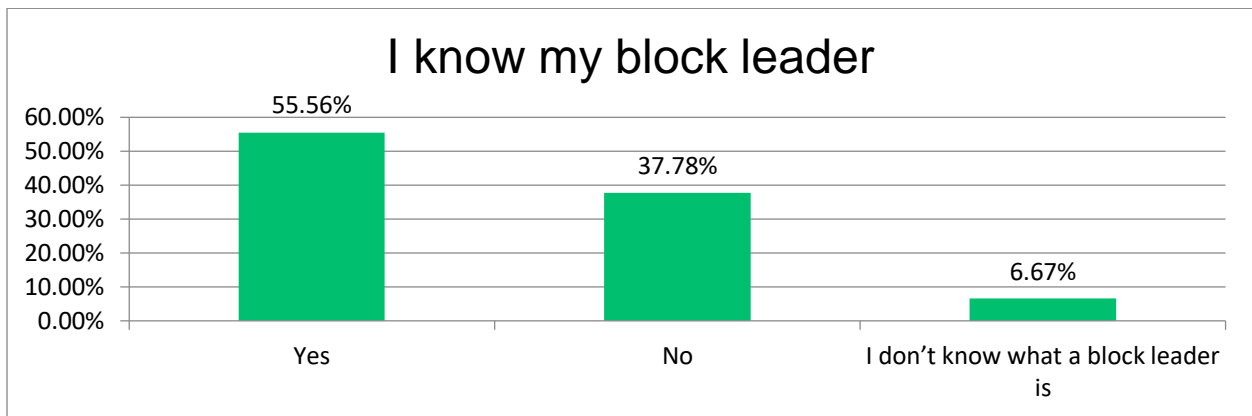

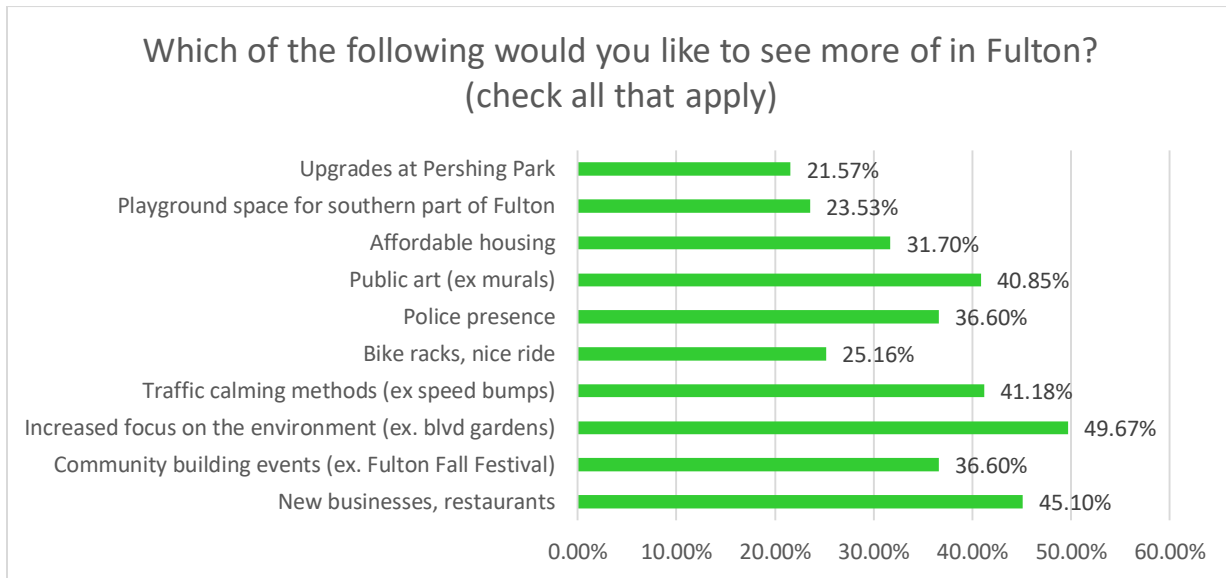

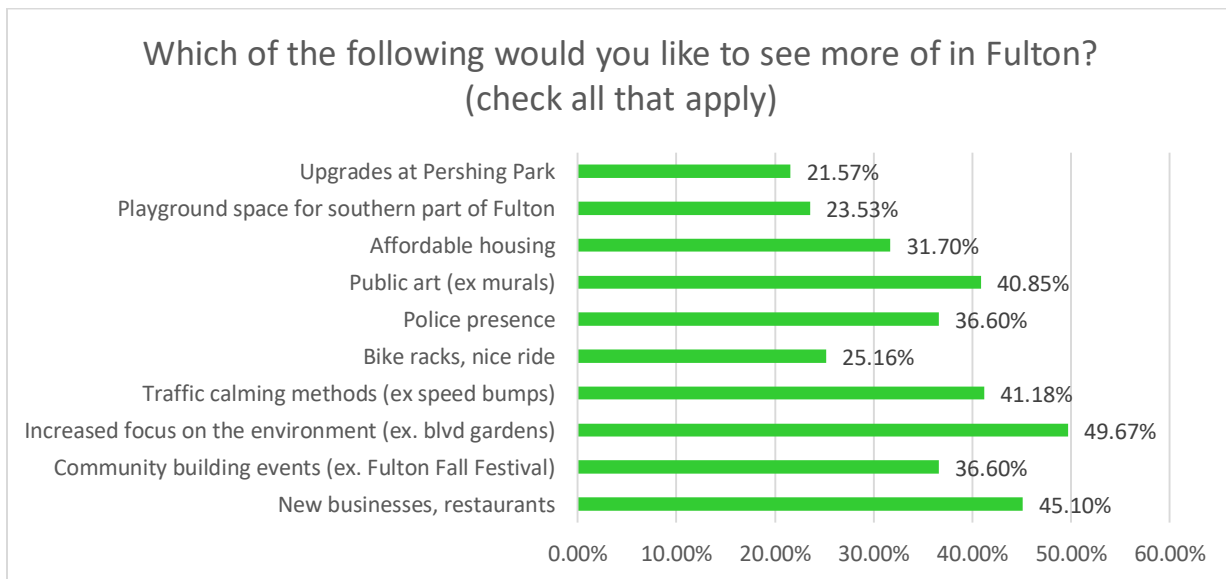

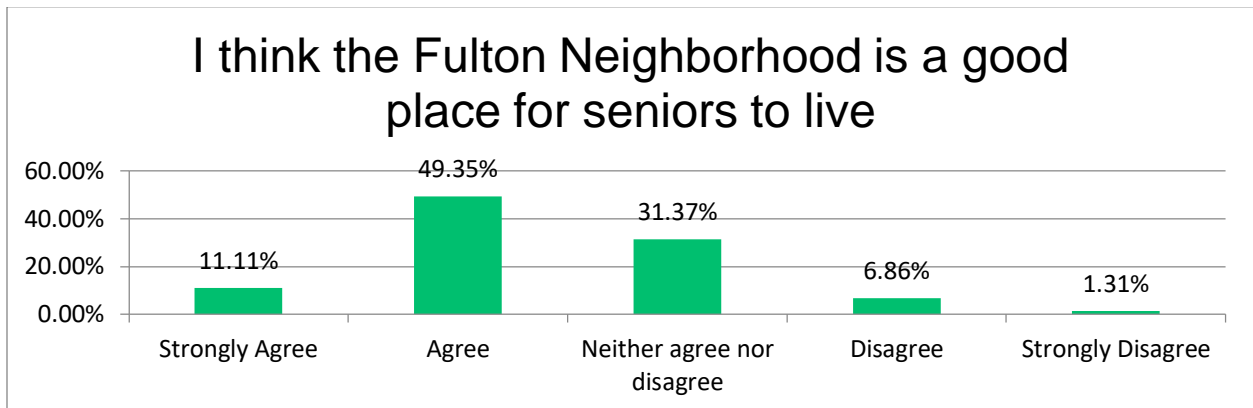
Respondents want to see increased focus on the environment (49%), new business and restaurants (45%), traffic calming methods (41%), and public art (40%)



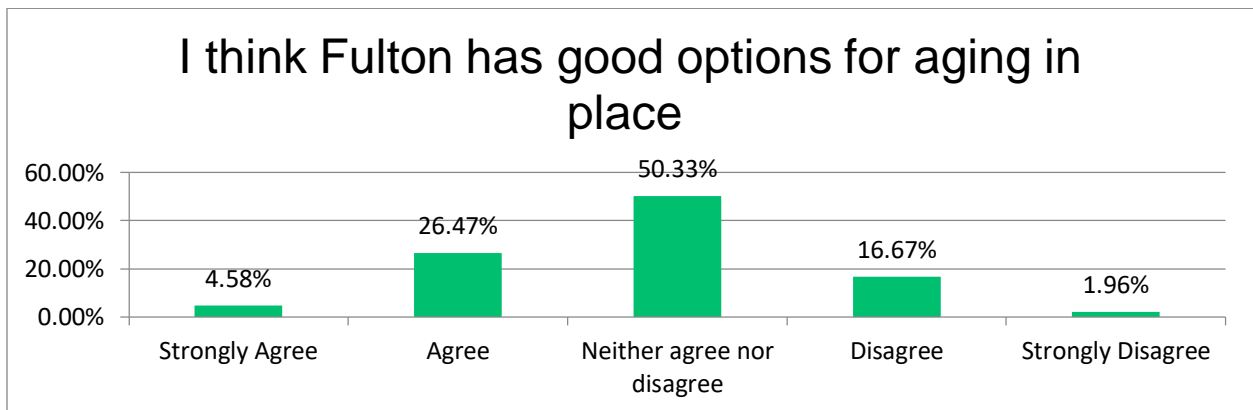
Most respondents would be interested in attending a neighborhood band concert (57%)

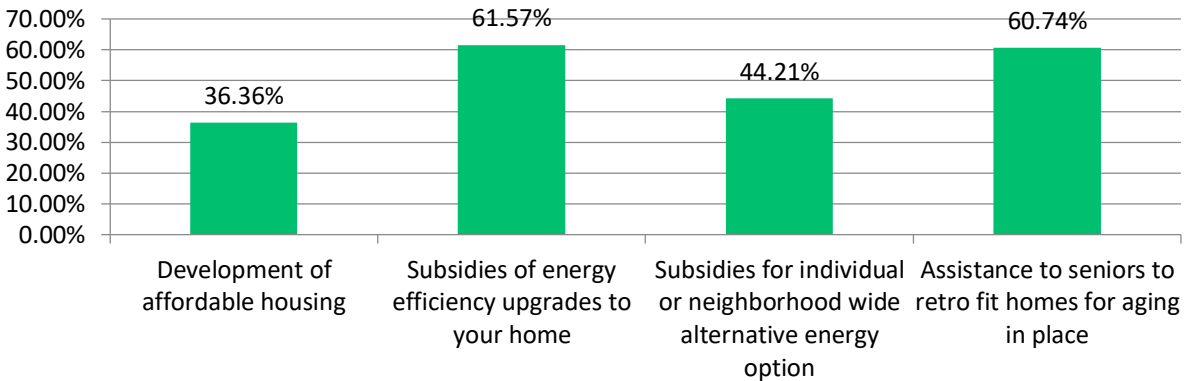

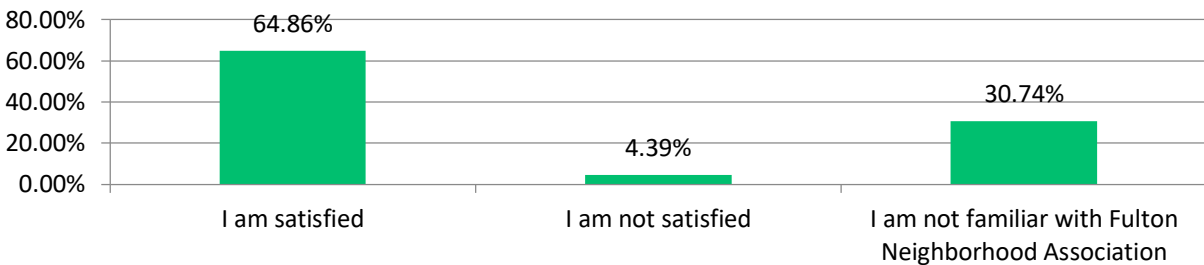

Due to an administrative change, FNA is no longer able to offer low-interest, revolving home improvement loans. What other type of housing related support would you like to see? (check all that apply)



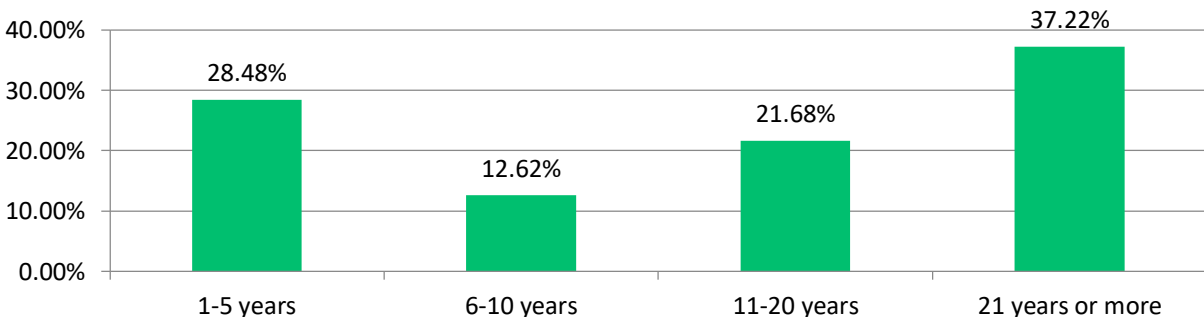
Most respondents are interested in energy efficiency upgrade subsidies (61%) and assistance to seniors to retrofit homes (60%)

I am satisfied with the Fulton Neighborhood Association:

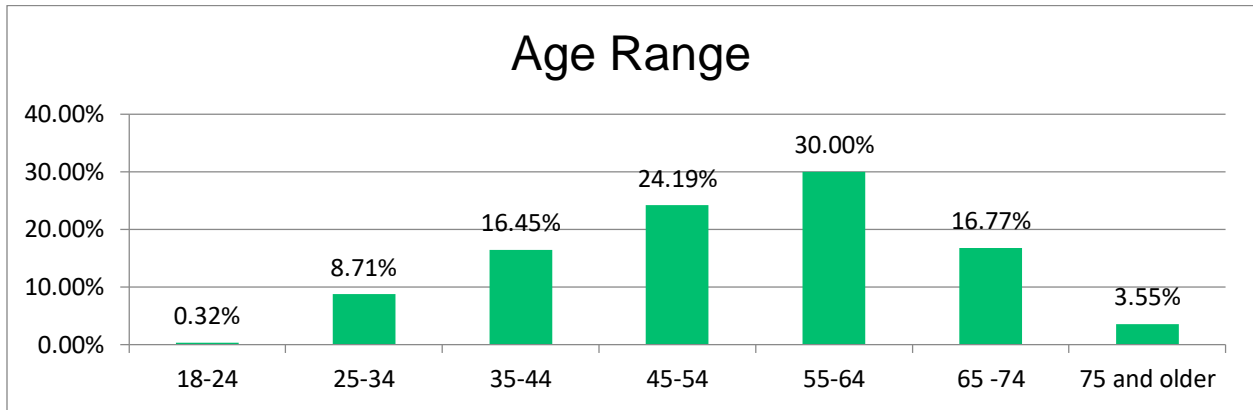


Most respondents are satisfied with the FNA (65%)

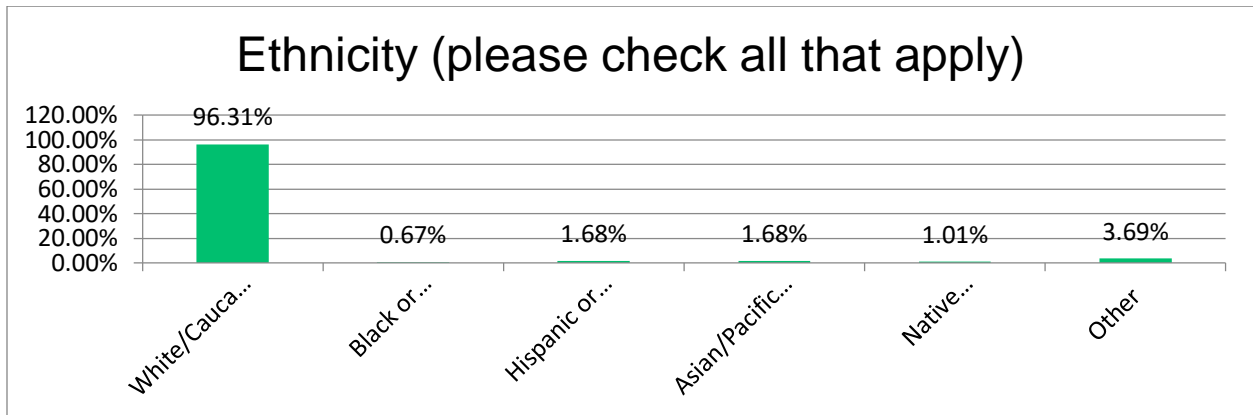
How long have you lived here?



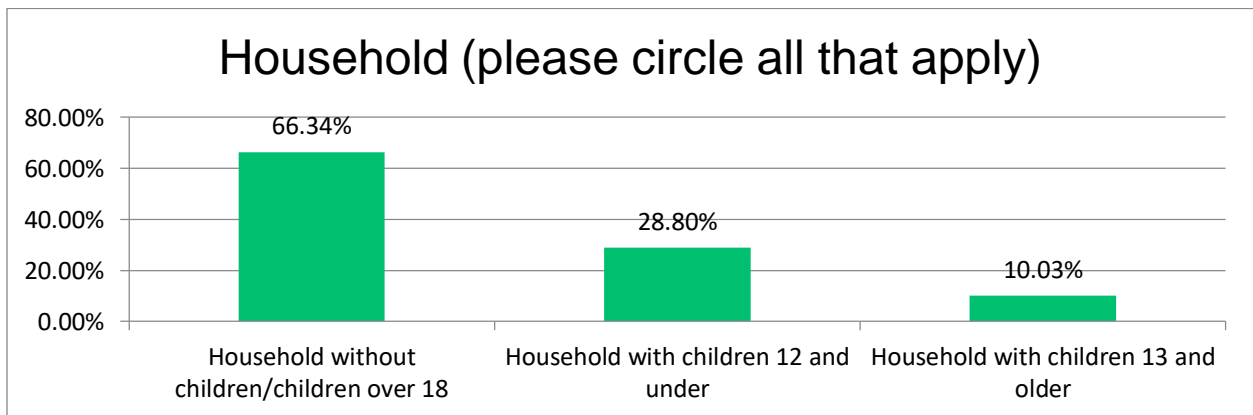
Most respondents have lived here for 21+ years (37%)
