2040

Some of the issues addressed were eminent domain, massing, parking and zoning. The Council did not pursue and extension for the deadline for submitting a plan to the Met Council.

Other business

The Southwest High School Foundation has reached out to Fulton and Linden Hills neighborhoods to co-host a reception for the outgoing interim principal as well as the incoming new principal.
