

Fulton Safety Committee report: May 8, 2019

Crime reports

Note: These are the reports from April 1 to 22.

April 1 At about 8:20 p.m., an unknown suspect entered a garage on the 4800 block of Upton, took unlisted item(s), and left northbound in the alley.

April 4 At about 9:15 p.m., a theft from motor vehicle occurred at Coalition Restaurant, 3808 West 50th St.

April 7 At about 7 p.m., a witness saw a male suspect inside a supply room at the rear of Coalition Restaurant, 3808 West 50th St. When the witness confronted him, the suspect walked out an unlocked door and left in an unknown direction. Items were found to be missing from the premises. The responding officers noted that there appear to be no surveillance cameras in the parking lot.

April 8 Between 5:45 and 8:00 p.m., a theft from motor vehicle occurred at 50th & France.

April 10 At about 10:40 p.m., officers responded to an aggravated robbery of person at 53rd & Chown. 18-year-old Makeiyen Lashaun Thompson of 3434 Emerson Ave North was arrested for aggravated robbery of person and booked in the jail. Two 16-year-old males and two 17-year-old males were arrested for aggravated robbery of person and booked at the Juvenile Detention Center. Handgun(s) were used and shot(s) were fired. The public information police report mentions the following offenses in addition to aggravated robbery: carrying a weapon without a permit, illegal discharge of a weapon, fleeing police in a motor vehicle, recovery of a stolen motor vehicle, hit-and-run property damage, and fleeing police on foot. The report lists one victim of aggravated robbery, one victim of damage to motor vehicle, and seven witnesses.
