

Fulton Safety Committee report: October 9, 2019

Crime reports

Note: These are the reports from September 1 to September 23.

September 1 An unknown suspect stole a TV, gaming stations, a Blu-ray player, and two laptop computers from an apartment in a building on the 2900 block of West 50th St. A resident returned home and found the apartment door open.

September 3 At about 1:15 p.m., a juvenile male approached another juvenile near 48th & Chowen, snatched his headphones off, and fled.

September 3 Between 4:15 and 5:00 p.m., an unknown suspect stole a backpack from Pershing Park, 3523 West 48th St. The backpack belonged to a person who was at soccer practice.

September 4 Overnight, an unknown suspect took a phone, chargers, and ear buds from a vehicle which was parked on the street on the 4900 block of York.

September 9 Overnight, an unknown suspect entered a garage on the 5300 block of Vincent through an unlocked service door, entered an unlocked vehicle which was parked inside, and took a garage door opener, tools, binoculars, and other items.

September 11 At about 3 a.m., officers were dispatched to a burglary in progress at a home on the 5300 block of York. Other officers arrived prior to those dispatched to the call and found a window screen cut on the north side of the house. Items were taken from the kitchen. After officers checked the house for suspects, the owner found that car keys were missing and that the car had been stolen. Meanwhile, multiple calls came in regarding prowlers trying to get into other houses in the area. Officers went to a home on the 5300 block of Abbott where a window screen had been cut. Other officers then reported that they were chasing a suspect near Minnehaha Creek. Three suspects were apprehended and the car stolen from the address on York Ave was recovered along with another vehicle which had been stolen from somewhere in the 3rd Precinct.

September 13 At about 8 p.m., a person approached a Metro Transit bus stop on France Ave near 50th St. Two males were standing at the bus stop and one asked the person if she knew what time the bus came. The person was trying to answer the suspect as she walked away. One of the suspects then grabbed her purse and tried to pull it off her arm. The person fought with one of the suspects; the other one punched her in the head and knocked her to the ground. Both suspects then ran off with her purse.

September 13 Overnight, an unknown suspect stole a Vespa scooter which was parked on the street on the 2400 block of West 53rd St.

September 20 At about 2:45 p.m., suspects smashed out the front passenger side window of a vehicle which was parked in the lot behind Broder's Cucina Italiana, 2308 West 50th St. and took a purse from the front seat. There is surveillance video of the suspects.
