

Fulton Safety Committee report: December 11, 2019

Crime reports from November 1 to 25.

November 8 At about 9:05 p.m., a person was walking southbound on Abbott Ave approaching 53rd St., talking on his cell phone. A male suspect came up behind him and wrapped his arms around the person's torso. A second male suspect appeared in front of the person and pointed a gun in his face and demanded money. The person told them that he did not have any money on him. The suspects went through his pockets, didn't find any money, and then demanded his cell phone. The person gave them his phone. The suspects then ran northbound on Abbott Ave. The person was not injured and called 911 from his home nearby. Officers responded and searched the area, but did not find the suspects, who were described as being 15 to 16 years old.

November 9 A known male suspect was found inside a home that was vacant and being remodeled on the 5300 block of Beard. The son of the owner came across the suspect in the basement, drinking wine. He ordered the suspect to leave. The suspect took a sweater and sports coat from the home and left. The suspect is the son of the homeowner's girlfriend. Police issued an arrest order for the suspect.

November 18 Overnight, an unknown suspect entered a construction site on the 5000 block of Ewing and took some hand and power tools from a large tool box inside the garage area.

November 20 Between 2:30 and 4:30 p.m., an unknown suspect smashed out a window of a vehicle which was parked in the underground ramp at 4999 France Ave and took a duffle bag, clothes, make-up, and miscellaneous toiletries.
