The City of Minneapolis will be holding office hours at Pershing Park

The City of Minneapolis will be holding office hours to get feedback and give information on the West Fulton Improvement Plan.

Office hours will be held at the Pershing Park Rec Center from 2-4pm Tuesdays from August 12-September 16.

This is a major reconstruction project in our neighborhood from France to Xerxes and its goals are to increase safety and traffic calming, improve pavement condition, and improve stormwater and drainage.



Planning has been in the works for several years and construction is scheduled to start next year and last until 2030.

## Upcoming Bystander Training



Bystander intervention training gives us tools to intervene without compromising our own safety. When we intervene, we don't just reduce trauma for the person being harassed. The goal of the training is to give participants the tools to intervene the next time they witness harassment in public spaces.
