

Slow drain water bucket

Try this easy method for watering, developed by Fulton resident Skip Fox.

Supplies:

- 1 plastic five gallon bucket
- 1 ~3/16-inch screw (optional)

Tools:

Drill with 3/16-inch bit

How to make:

Drill a hole in the bucket on the side, about an inch up from the bottom. Insert screw into hole.

How to use:

- Insert screw into hole to help keep yourself dry while transporting bucket.
- Fill bucket with water.
- Carry to base of tree and position to direct water stream to desired area. Remove screw and drop in bucket so you can find it later.
- Empties in about 15 minutes.
- Repeat for 20 gallons per week (about five buckets.)
